The plot follows a Kashmiri Hindu college student, raised by his exiled grandfather and shielded from the knowledge of the circumstances of the death of his parents.

The plot alternates between the student's quest in the present time, 2020, and his family's travails of thirty years before.

"Very unique, cool and rare character, which is hard to create in our crazy world of pro wrestling." "Still processing losing the goat, Terry Funk yesterday and now Bray today," The Rock added. "My love, light, strength & mana to the Rotunda family and Funk family during this tough, heart-breaking time. As always, 'thank you for the house' #ohana," he added. According to Acheshowbiz, as well as sharing the ring at WrestleMania 32, Dwayne Johnson has plenty in common with the late wrestler as the two had been long time friends. Both The Rock and Bray Wyatt were a pair that hailed from illustrious wrestling families that have spanned multiple generations.
